

Take part in - Clive's Cumbrian Way

Resurrecting an existing 260mile cycle route in two days!

The Challenge

On June the 12th-13th a group of Cumbrian cyclist headed by the Honister 92 CC, will circumnavigate the counties boundaries covering 260miles in two days. A challenging weekend of cycling for even the most dedicated seasoned cyclist.

The reason

We have decided to dedicated this challenge to Clive Jenkins, a 42year old Sellafield worker who is suffering from Motor Neuron disease, and in honour of being able to use his name to spearhead our campaign we endeavour to make this challenge a yearly event and raise money to support the Make a Wish Foundation. A Charity that grants magical wishes to children and young people fighting life threatening illnesses.

The Goal

Our goal is to make this challenge unique in many ways and like an acorn develops into a mighty oak, we hope our event will grow from a small number of thirty or so riders in year one, to become the premier event of its kind in our area.

The Format

Not a sportive, not a race, but an individual challenge participated by a group of riders. We will do our best to categorise three distinct groups, based on ability and experience. Suggesting that the stronger riders in any given group will assist the not so, thus completing the ride in the spirit Clive and the person he is. A fast group averaging 18-19 mph, an intermediate group (16-17 mph) and a slower group (15-16 mph) should ensure everyone is challenged, whilst keeping this a social occasion. Its very important that you enjoy it.

The Cost

Overnight accommodation at the Arnside YHA, our half way point, has been negotiated at £30.00 per head. This includes a three course meal in the evening and an early breakfast. Added to this is the entry fee that will go directly to the make a wish foundation, and any cost incurred from the feed stops and mobile backups etc. Finishing off with supper at the Sheep and Wool Centre in Cockermouth on completion, this makes the total cost per rider £80.00, not a great deal of money for 2 superb days cycling and a great social event.

The Rewards

As well as the obvious rewards for our charity, you will have participated in an epic 2 day biking challenge that was set up originally to be completed in 7days. As well as the pies and beers to follow at our HQ we would hope to follow the weekend up with a social evening at the Black Cock in Eaglesfield, to yet again celebrate our achievements. On a personal level for anyone who knows Clive, it will be an honour to cycle Clive's Cumbrian Way!
